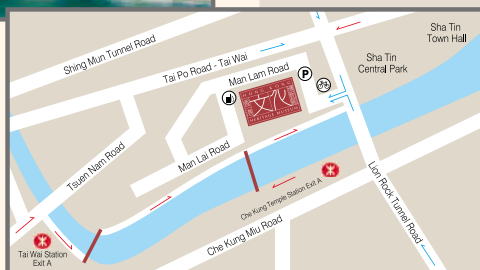


7. Cantonese Opera Appreciation Class

Cantonese opera is a highly respected art form that blends Chinese legend, music and drama into an exciting performance style, rich in symbolic meaning. It was included as part of UNESCO's "Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity" programme in 2009. This class guides you through the Hong Kong Heritage Museum's Cantonese Opera Heritage Hall and its numerous displays, so that you can develop a better understanding of this unique art form. Visitors will be able to view the elaborate costumes worn by performers and attend a live operatic performance by a local troupe.

- 🚇 MTR Che Kung Temple Station, Exit A, cross footbridge and walk 5 minutes to the Museum. Or take bus 80M from MTR Kowloon Tong Station and alight at "Hong Kong Heritage Museum" bus-stop (about 10 minutes journey).
