MTR Tips

Tourist Day Pass

The HK\$55 Tourist Day Pass or HK\$25 Child Tourist Day Pass allow you to enjoy one day of unlimited travel on the MTR. The Day Pass is valid for one month from the date of issue.

Visitors can also buy an Airport Express Travel Pass that covers Airport Express journeys and 3 days of unlimited travel on the MTR. Check the MTR website for the latest information.

Octopus Card

The Octopus card is a stored value electronic card widely used in Hong Kong for public transport, purchases at convenience stores, fast food restaurants, supermarkets, cake shops, vending machines, etc. Simply place the Octopus card on a reader and the amount of purchase will be automatically deducted from the stored value.
