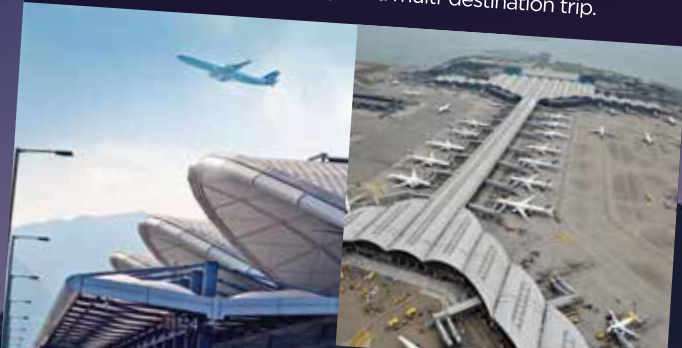
Visa-free
